

## Indianapolis IN - March 17-20, 2013

The Alliance 2013 conference is 10 days away! Here are some important information items you may need as you prepare for your conference participation.

**ID REQUIRED:** You will be required to show identification when picking up your registration materials at the conference. The registration area for all attendees is in the Indiana Convention Center – West Lobby – Level 1 (across from the Westin). Name badges **must** be worn to all conference functions.

**CHECK-IN:** In addition to your name badge, at check-in you will receive a conference tote bag, water bottle, program guide and coupon book. We will have water stations throughout the Convention Center to fill your bottle. **Don't lose the coupon book** – it contains special ads from our sponsors and vendors **AND the drink tickets** for the Sunday Opening Reception and the Tuesday night event.

**PROGRAM GUIDE:** Attendees this year will receive a printed guide instead of a program at registration. The guide will be a packet that includes handouts for each day plus one general information handout. The handout for each day will include the schedule for the day and a list of the sessions by track and by time. The title of each session and its location will be listed in a grid to make it easy to navigate. Complete session information including description and presenter information will still be available on the conference website to help you build your agenda. **TRANSPORTATION:** Because all of our conference hotels are within easy walking distance of the convention and many connect to the convention center via 2<sup>nd</sup> level skywalks, transportation for sessions and events will not be needed this year.
